Qualification aim

This qualification informs and guides learners through the process of understanding the requirements and commitments and values, along with an introduction to the skills and knowledge expected when entering Military life. It provides the foundation underpinning as well as specific and more detailed information to provide access to the military services as well as opportunity for progression.

Qualification introduction

This qualification is made up of eight mandatory units that will help learners to develop an understanding of the sector as well as significant areas of skills, knowledge and performance that are required for success at initial selection for military life. The fundamental units are a step-by-step process to introduce learners to the initial requirements, with the more specific units providing scope and opportunity to gain a greater understanding, skills and knowledge in the wide military life.

Assessment

In order to achieve this qualification a learner must complete all units as mandatory. The assessment criteria determine the standard required to achieve each unit and allow for a variety of assessment methods to be used as appropriate to the environment the qualification is delivered in. There is no examined assessment element in this qualification.

Progression

On completion of this qualification learners will be prepared to progress to a variety of careers within the armed forces, specialist level 2 or 3 qualifications in a range of occupations within the service would be suitable, this could include but not limited to apprenticeships.

Achievement

In order to achieve this qualification, learners must complete all of the units within the qualification to gain the 37 credits applicable to the qualification.
