Qualification aim

This qualification informs and guides learners through the process of understanding and securing employment in the Construction sector. It provides a structured individualised route with knowledge and skills specific to the sector and how it operates.

Qualification introduction

This qualification is made up of mandatory units that will help learners to develop an understanding of the labour market and how best they can enter and secure employment relative to their capabilities and aspirations. Its mandatory units are a step by step process to prepare, source and secure employment in the sector. Learners who complete the units will be equipped with the knowledge, skills and resources to initiate and remain engaged with employment that suits their circumstances.
