Qualification aim

This qualification informs and guides learners in developing an understanding of the skills, knowledge and principles that underpin the manufacturing environment.

Qualification introduction

This qualification provides learners with a broad and relevant understanding of the techniques, statutory requirements and skills required to underpin a career in the manufacturing environment.

Assessment

In order to achieve this qualification a learner must complete 13 credits by completing the 4 mandatory units. The assessment criteria determine the standard required to achieve each unit and allow for a variety of assessment methods to be used as appropriate to the environment the qualification is delivered in. There is no examined assessment element in this qualification.

Progression

On completion of this qualification learners will be prepared to progress to a variety of apprenticeship opportunities in the manufacturing environment in addition to stand alone competence and knowledge qualifications at level 2 & 3.

Learners must achieve a total of 13 credits by completing the 4 mandatory units within the qualification.
