Qualification aim

This qualification is a Vocationally Related Qualification (VRQ) which focuses on the knowledge practical skills associated with business improvement. Assessment

The assessment criteria determine the standard required to achieve each unit and allow for a variety of assessment methods to be used as appropriate to the environment the qualification is delivered in. There is no examined assessment element in this qualification.

Achievement

Learners must achieve a minimum of 40 credits to gain the qualification. 25 credits must be achieved by completing the 5 mandatory units and the remaining credits achieved by completing the required optional units Option Group 1 and Option Group 2.
